



How to apply for Applied Conflict Transformation Studies (ACTS) MA Programme

Do not return this page to the ACTS office. Keep it for your own reference. It is a guide how to complete your application correctly.

Step 1: Before beginning the application process, read through the following criteria for ACTS students and determine your eligibility for the course:

The selection criteria for ACTS students are:

Student should be living and working within the boundaries of the Asia Pacific
region
Experience in participative learning methodology in the field of conflict
transformation or related fields
Willingness to participate in a diverse, cross-cultural, interfaith learning
environment
At least five years work experience in conflict transformation or related fields
Support of employer
Capacity to cope with demands of the course, including self-directed action-
research
Commitment to peace and justice values
Self-awareness and openness to receiving feedback
Access to computer, email, internet, skype, WhatsApp, Telegram, and regularly
communicate
Fluency in use of the English language (required to pass IELTS score 6.0 or TOEFI
of 550)
High School degree and Undergraduate degree are essential (non-negotiable)
Over the age of 25 years

Step 2: If you feel satisfied with your eligibility, please proceed and complete the following forms:

- ✓ ACTS Application Form
- ✓ Reference Form (at least two including)
- ✓ Supervisor/Line Manager Statement
- ✓ Statement of Motivation

Step 3: Prepare the following documents:

- Your curriculum vitae or resume
- Copy of your High School certificate/diploma and High School transcript (with notarised translation if not in English)
- Copy of your Bachelor Degree academic transcript and Bachelor's certificate/diploma (with notarised translation if not in English)
- ✓ Copy of your IELTS OR TOEFL test results, taken within the last 2 years (Note ACTS requires IELTS of 6.0 or TOEFL of 550)
- Scanned copy of passport

Step 4: Email these forms and scanned copies of your documents before September 30, 2021 to: centrepeaceconflictstudies@gmail.com. Know that this is a rolling application system so the sooner we receive, the sooner we can proceed with the process.

Step 5: Request three (3) referees to complete the referee forms and send to: centrepeaceconflictstudies@gmail.com before November 1, 2020.

Step 6: Fill up the PUC Application form to be sent by the ACTS Admin team and send back to same email.
